

At the writing of this article, the 190th Annual communication of the Grand Lodge of Florida has ended. New legislation was passed at this communication that will help improve the masonic home and add facilities to make it even better than it is now. Your continued support is always encouraged with the payment of your dues.

As is probably already stated in other articles, the passing of  $M \cdot W \cdot V$ . John E. Karroum on Friday May 31st is indeed a shock. The Grand Master became ill during the legislative session on Tuesday morning and left the Grand Lodge room. When outside the Grand Lodge room he collapsed and was taken to the hospital. His friendship and leadership will be sorely missed by all the Masons in this and other Grand Jurisdictions.

Speaking of Dues, there are 78 brothers who have not

paid their dues for 2019. Second notices for payment will be sent out later in the month of June and I encourage you to pay your dues as soon as possible to avoid the last minute rush at the end of the year when we will be collecting dues for 2020. All dues for the current year are due by December 27th of that year and if not paid by that date you will be suspended for nonpayment of dues.

Payment of dues can be done on line through Circumscribe and before long, that will be only way to pay dues. The Grand Lodge is moving toward using the circumscribe card as your dues card and if you don't have the Circumscribe card you will not have a dues card to show at a lodge when you go to visit a lodge or come to lodge to participate. If you don't own a computer, you can use one at a library or better yet, get your grandchildren to help you get into Circumscribe and register and make payments. Instructions on how to use circumscribe are at the bottom of this article.

We currently have four candidates that are ready for initiation and have more petitions coming in.

#### First Time Circumscribe Log In Instructions

- Open your internet browser
- Navigate to: https://glfl.circumscribe.net
- Enter your initial Username:
  "FL" + "Your Grand Lodge Number" + "@changeyouremail.info" (example: FL1234567@changeyouremail.info)
- Enter your temporary Password: "FL" + "Your Grand Lodge" (example: FL1234567)
- You will be immediately prompted to change both your username and password
- Your NEW username can be any email address that you frequently use, or have regular
- Your NEW password must contain at least eight characters and one number. You must enter it twice.
- Upon successfully entering both, you will be required to logout, and then log back in with your new credentials.
- Once you have logged back in, select 'Profile' from the menu items on the left side of the screen. Review your profile and make any appropriate changes, or contact the Lodge Secretary if you require other changes.
- Finally, úpload a current picture for your new permanent ID card. Please avoid hats, sunglasses, other individuals or animals in the picture.
- Select 'Save Profile' to complete the process.

Most Worshipful John E. Karroum was born in Damascus, Syria, on January 22, 1950, Most Worshipful Karroum received the Three Symbolic Degrees of Freemasonry in Zahle Lodge No. 1047, Chartered by The Grand Lodge of Scotland in Zahle, Lebanon, in 1977, was a Dual Member of Boynton Lodge No. 236, and a Plural Member of Apalachicola Lodge No. 76.

Additionally, he has served in several capacities as a District and Zone Chairman. In 2012 Most Worshipful Jorge L. Aladro appointed him the Right Worshipful District Deputy Grand Master of the 24th Masonic District. Since 2013 he has had the privilege of serving on the Grand Lodge's Endowment and Investment Committee and as a Member of the Masonic Home Board of Trustees where he chaired the Masonic Home Operations Committee.

Most Worshipful Westerman was elected to the Office of Junior Grand Warden in May of 2016 at the 187th Annual Grand Communication; Senior Grand Warden in May of 2017; Deputy Grand Master in May of 2018; and was elected and installed Grand Master at the 190th An-

nual Grand Communication on May 29, 2019.

Most Worshipful Westerman is a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason in the Valley of Tampa and has been Invested a Knight Commander of the Court of Honor. He is also a proud member of Lakeland Commandery No. 21 of the Knights Templar; the Lakeland Council No. 11 of the Royal and Select Masters; the Lakeland Chapter No. 29 of the Royal Arch Masons; the Saint Bernard de Clairvaux Conclave of the Red Cross of Constantine; the Winter Haven Council No. 115 of the Allied Masonic Degrees; and the Mystic Brotherhood Council No. 35 of the Knight Masons. Most Worshipful Westerman additionally enjoys fellowship and philanthropy as a member of the Egypt Shriners and Sesame Grotto.
