HISTORICAL SPOTLIGHT: A THANKSGIVING PROCLAWATION

Written by George Washington in 1789, this was the first official Presidential Proclamation made in the United States. Shortly after the Thanksgiving Proclamation was written, it was lost for 130 years. It was probably misplaced when the US Capitol moved from New York to Washington, D.C. It now resides in the Library of Congress. And it reads:

Whereas it is the duty of all nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey His will, to be grateful for His benefits, and humbly to implore His protection and favor; and Whereas both Houses of Congress have, by their joint committee, requested me to "recommend to the people of the United States a day of public thanksgiving and prayer, to be observed by acknowledging with grateful hearts the many and signal favors of Almighty God, especially by affording them an opportunity peaceably to establish a form of government for their safety and happiness:"

Now, therefore, I do recommend and assign Thursday, the 26th day of November next, to be devoted by the people of these States to the service of that great and glorious Being who is the beneficent author of all the good that was, that is, or that will be; that we may then all unite in rendering unto Him our sincere and humble thanks for His kind care and protection of the people of this country previous to their becoming a nation; for the signal and manifold mercies and the favorable interpositions of His providence in the

WHEREAS it is the duty of all nations to acknowledge the Providence of Almighty God---to obey his will---to be grateful for his benefits---and humbly to implore his protection and favour: And whereas both Houses have, by their joint committee, requested me "to recommend to the people of the United States, a DAY of PUBLICK THANKSGIVING and PRAY-ER, to be observed by acknowledging with grateful heatts the many and fignal favours of Almighty God, especially by affording them an opportunity peaceably to establish a form of government for their safety and happiness:"

course and conclusion of the late war; for the great degree of tranquility, union, and plenty which we have since enjoyed; for the peaceable and rational manner in which we have been enable to establish constitutions of government for our safety and happiness, and particularly the national one now lately instituted for the civil and religious liberty with which we are blessed, and the means we have of acquiring and diffusing useful knowledge; and, in general, for all the great and various favors which He has been pleased to confer upon us.

And also that we may then unite in most humbly offering our prayers and supplications to the great Lord and Ruler of Nations and beseech Him to pardon our national and other transgressions; to enable us all,



whether in public or private stations, to perform our several and relative duties properly and punctually; to render our National Government a blessing to all the people by constantly being a Government of wise, just, and constitutional laws, discreetly and faithfully executed and obeyed; to protect and guide all sovereigns and nations (especially such as have shown kindness to us), and to bless them with good governments, peace, and concord; to promote the knowledge and practice of true religion and virtue, and the increase of science among them and us; and, generally to grant unto all mankind such a degree of temporal prosperity as He alone knows to be best.

Given under my hand, at the city of New York, the 3d day of October, A.D. 1789.



First Time Circumscribe Log In Instructions

- Open your internet browser
- Navigate to: https://glfl.circumscribe.net
- Enter your initial Username:
 - "FL" + "Your Grand Lodge Number" + "@changeyouremail.info"

(example: FL1234567@changeyouremail.info)

- Enter your temporary Password:
 - "FL" + "Your Grand Lodge #" (example: FL1234567)
- You will be immediately prompted to change both your username and password
- Your NEW username can be any email address that you frequently use, or have regular access to.
- Your NEW password must contain at least eight characters and one number. You must enter it twice.
- Upon successfully entering both, you will be required to logout, and then log back in with your new credentials.
- Once you have logged back in, select 'Profile' from the menu items on the left side of the screen. Review your profile and
 make any appropriate changes, or contact the Lodge Secretary if you require other changes.
- Finally, upload a current picture for your new permanent ID card. Please avoid hats, sunglasses, other individuals or animals in the picture.
- Select 'Save Profile' to complete the process.

Please note, if you or the Lodge Secretary have already added your personal email address to the system, you will need to log in using that email address and your known password or use the "forgot password" feature. If you aren't sure which email address you used, or if one is already in the system, email the Lodge Secretary at secretary@hillsborough25.org and he can verify the email address.

AFTARHZ FAFVFA JURA

November 19, 1920 was a revolutionary day for Florida (and Tampa) Freemasonry. On that date, Paul Revere Chapter received authorization from the Grand Council of DeMolay to begin working towards a Charter. "PRC" as it is affectionately known, was the first DeMolay Chapter in the State of Florida, originally sponsored by the Tampa Scottish Rite Bodies in the building next door. Hillsborough Lodge assumed the sponsorship in 1957 under the direction and leadership of Worshipful Master Gerald Smith. Having been a DeMolay in my youth, I will join several of our Brethren in an annual observance to honor the memory of DeMolay's Founder, Ill. Frank Sherman Land, 33°, on November 8 – the anniversary of his passing to the Celestial Lodge above (he passed in 1959).

PRC has recently undergone a period of reorganization, where the focus was re-centered on the development of our youth members. Our Master Councilor, Christian Meguiar, earned the Past Master Councilor's Meritorious Service Award for a stellar term of office during the quarantine. He is now serving a second term, and is balancing a schedule of in-person and virtual activities to keep the Chapter members engaged. In 2020, PRC has initiated seven new Brothers and attained positive growth for the year – one of only three Chapters in Florida thus far to earn this distinction.




