He attended Golden Gate University while serving in the Air Force. The lodge now has a credit or debit card payment option using Square. Annual dues, fees, and items from the merchandise cases can be purchased using a credit or debit card this way. Service fees will, however, be applied to this payment method. A QR code will also be available on the sign in the dining room that will allow for payment of a \$10 dinner donation too.

I would like to congratulate the members of the Membership Retention Committee for their terrific work contacting delinquent members to check on them. Over the last several years, the committee has contacted, by any means possible, members who end up on our delinquent list. As we pass June 30th, delinquent notices had to be sent out. We sent out 110 notices in 2020, 50 in 2021, and now 'only' 44 in 2022. Through phone calls, emails, and snail mail... we are able to reach most members. Most of the time, an incorrect mailing address is to blame. In some cases, we do not have phone numbers or email address for those who have been members for a long time. If you have any suggestions how to make your lodge experience better, I would love to hear them! If you have topic for an education night, please send them to me.


